The major fundraiser for the Friends of the Salem Free Public Library is the annual Used Book Sale. We are extremely proud of this event, which is held the last weekend in October in the gymnasium of Salem School. Friends' volunteers spend hundreds of hours sorting over 25,000 books into categories, making it easier for our customers to find the items that they're interested in.

Used books for the sale are collected year round in the drop boxes to the left of the Salem Free Public Library's main entrance. Wanted are used books (including children's books), DVDs, VHS tapes, CDs, cassette tapes, and software in good condition. Unfortunately, there is little demand for encyclopedias, old textbooks, condensed books, and magazines, so these items are not desired. Help can be obtained with large donations by calling 859-0165.
