Grades Pre-K through grade 3

Grades 4-8

- Read one book per week to receive a raffle ticket for the **weekly raffle**. One visit per week.

Grades 9-12

- Read one book per week to receive a raffle ticket for the **weekly raffle**. One visit per week.
