The EPPI training scenario identified an emergency event that would have required a school evacuation and the combination of events provided real time situational awareness during the drill that would have normally been theoretically performed. Discussion followed in regard to identified vulnerabilities and the need for additional EOC personnel.

B. Capital plan submittals are due by December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Discussed requesting funds for radios and what the EOC would require. EMD advised to communicate with Fire Department to collaborate on overall needs of the Town Agency's. Further discussion related to EOC enhancements such as relocating antennas on building roof to the tower.

C. EOC weather station has been fixed and is broadcasting.

## 7. New Business:

A. Salem's Emergency Resource Plan is being revised to identify current contact information in result of recent elections and personnel changes within various town stakeholder agencies. Suggestion from committee to establish document review for revisions twice a year. July to coincide with any personnel changes with the school district and November to coincide with any personnel changes in result of elections.

C. Outreach- Informed by the Registrars Office that we were not allowed to set up a table to sign people up for Everbridge in a voting place.
